DID YOU KNOW....

There were over 10,500 armed conflicts during the Civil War ranging from battles to minor skirmishes resulting in over 620,000 lives lost. Winchester is considered by many historians to have been the most fought over location of the Civil War, by some counts changing hands between North and South over 70 times. The people of this area were intensely loyal to Virginia and The South. In most counties of the Shenandoah Valley, the vote regarding secession ran over 99% in favor. There were few slaves in the region and cotton plantations were non-existent. There were no large cities. Most of the people were small farmers or held town occupations. But the Shenandoah Valley was a fruitful agricultural region and geography made it a natural corridor for the movement of armies between North and South - thus it was a strategic area of high importance. The first real invasion of the Shenandoah Valley was launched in early 1862. In March, Federal forces advancing from the north captured Winchester, quickly putting the town under military occupation. In May, Confederate forces under Stonewall Jackson counterattacked in hopes of liberating Winchester and its citizens. This would be the first of the three major battles over Winchester.

MAJOR CIVIL WAR ENGAGEMENTS IN WINCHESTER

FIRST BATTLE OF WINCHESTER, aka Bowers Hill. May 25, 1862 Result: Confederate victory Principal Commanders: Maj. Gen. Nathaniel P. Banks [US]; Maj. Gen. T.J. (Stonewall) Jackson [CS]
Forces Engaged: 22,500 total (US 6,500; CS 16,000) Estimated Casualties: 2,419 total (US 2,019; CS 400)

SECOND BATTLE OF WINCHESTER, June 13-15, 1863 Result: Confederate victory

Principal Commanders: Brig. Gen. Robert Milroy [US]; Lt. Gen. Richard S. Ewell [CS]

Forces Engaged: 19,500 total (US 7,000; CS 12,500) Estimated Casualties: 4,709 total (US 4,443; CS 266)

This Confederate victory cleared the Valley of Union troops and opened the door for Lee's second invasion of the North.

THIRD BATTLE OF WINCHESTER, aka Opequon. September 19, 1864 Result: Union victory

Principal Commanders: Maj. Gen. Philip Sheridan [US]; Lt. Gen. Jubal A. Early [CS]

Forces Engaged: 54,440 total (US 39,240; CS 15,200) Estimated Casualties: 8,630 total (US 5,020; CS 3,610)

Due to its size, intensity, and result, many historians consider this the most important conflict of the Shenandoah Valley.
